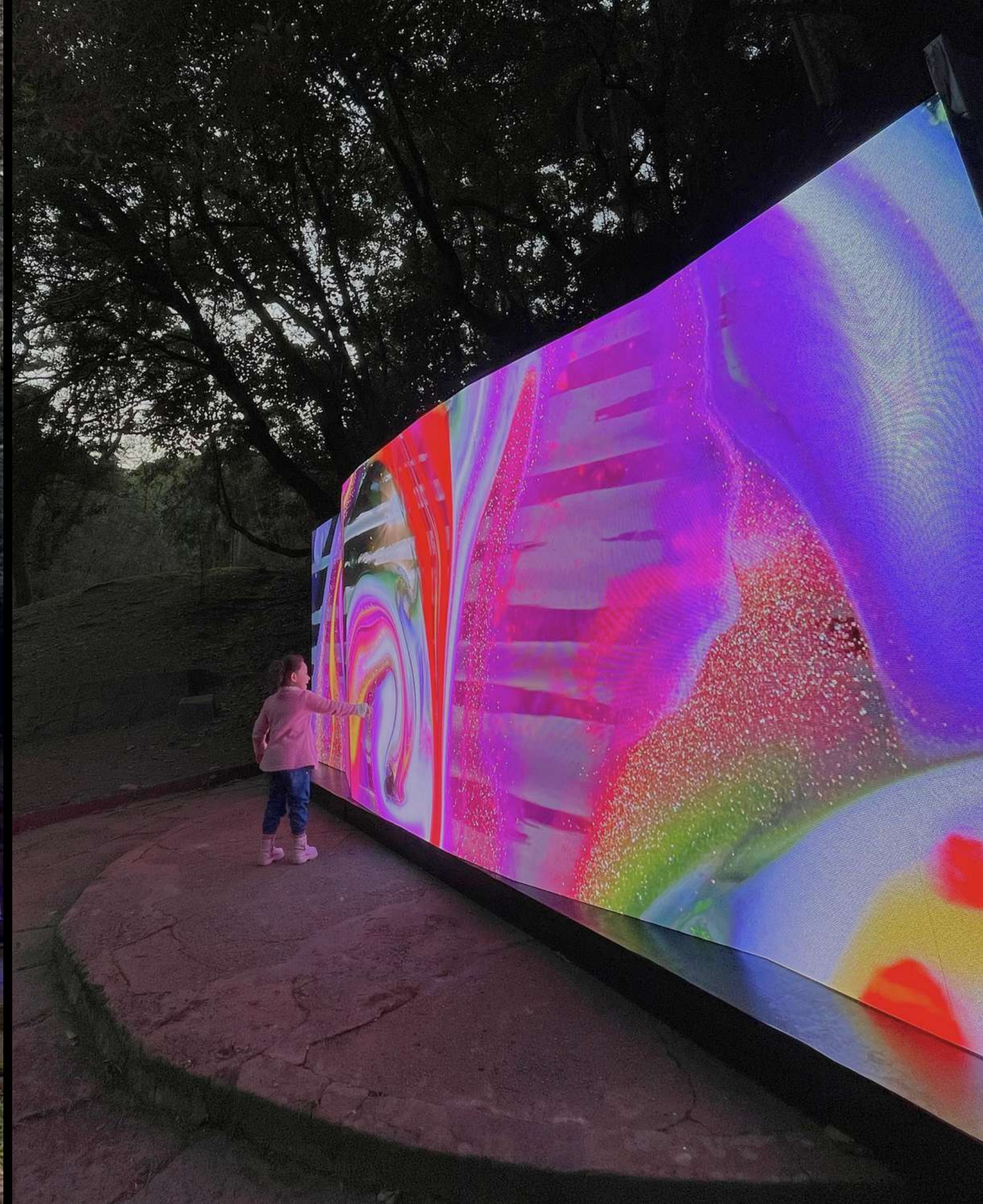
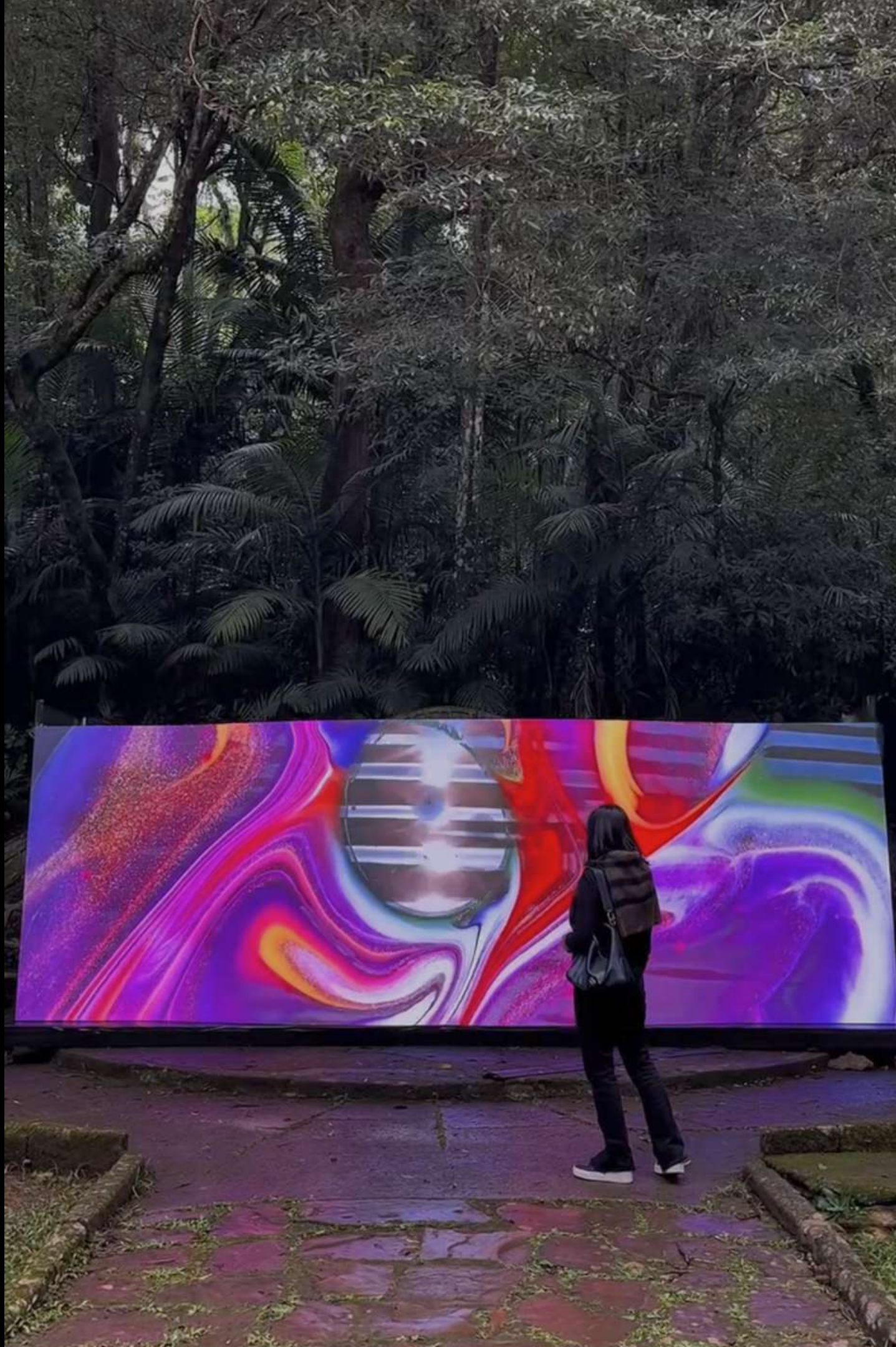

contemporary reality.

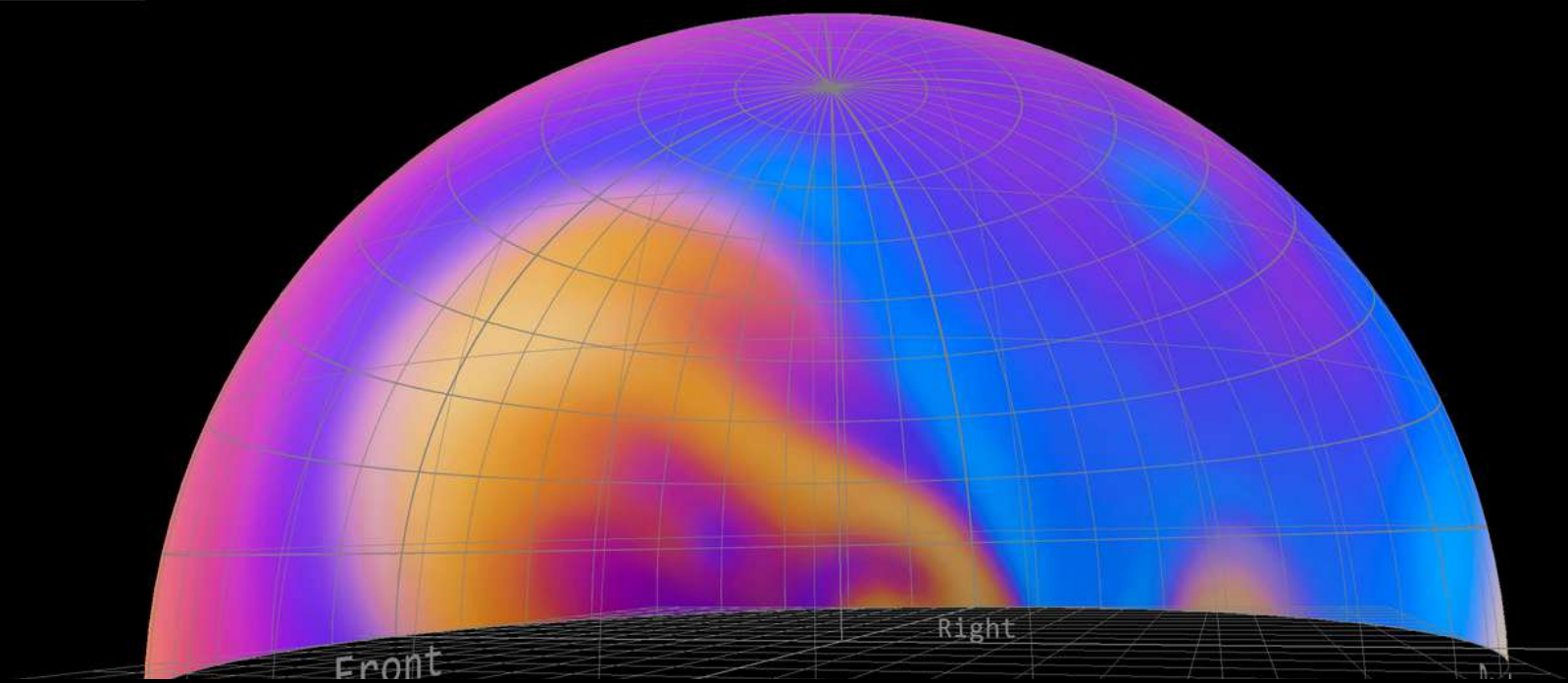

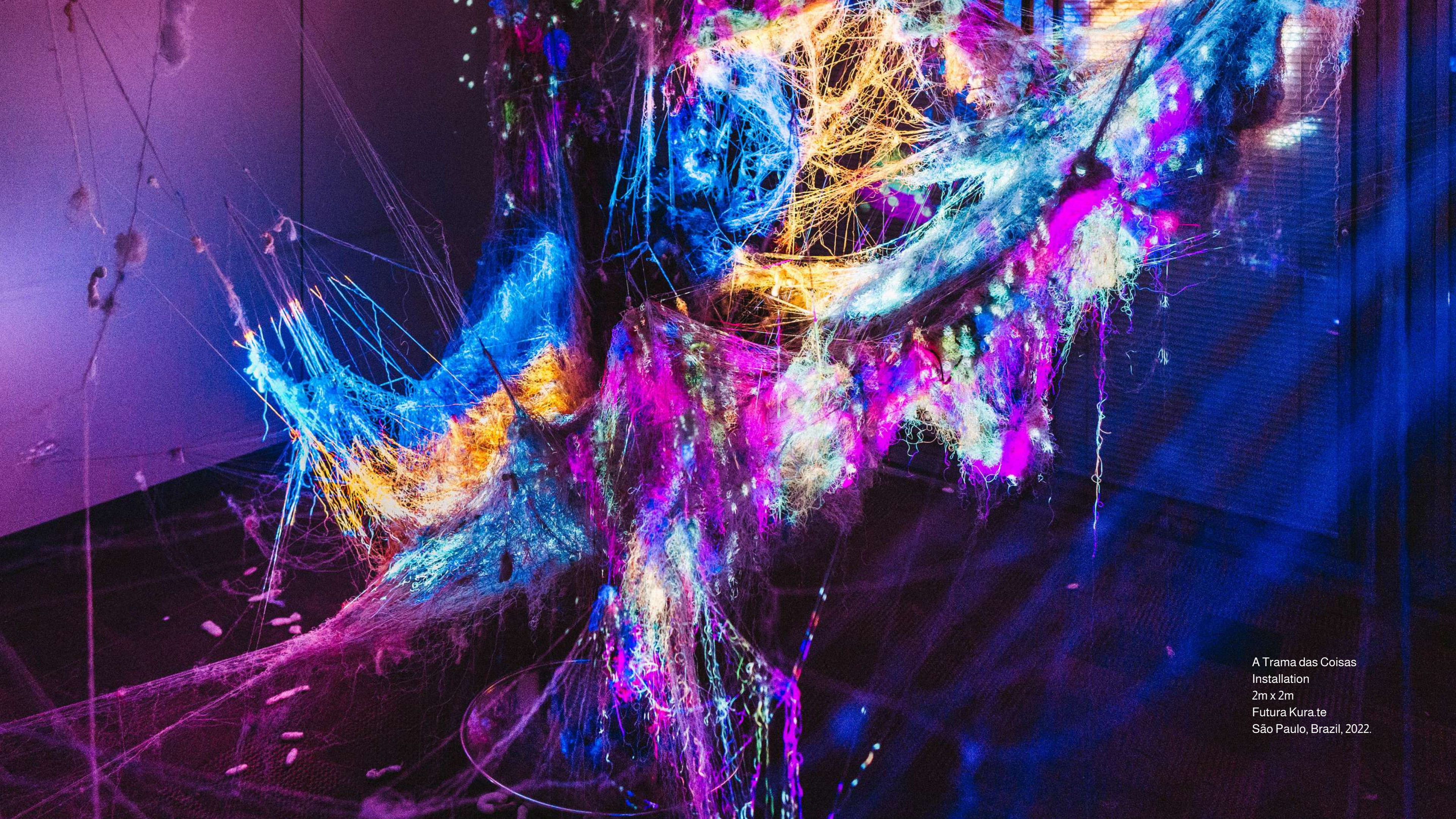
Audiovisual workshop developed by Via and Eigenklang Kollektiv in collaboration with the scientists and activists of Moorbündnis. 2026

The workshop explored different layers of the moor through image and sound. Participants recorded material in the field and in the studio using microscopes, drones, cameras and audio recording tools, moving between microscopic views, landscape perspectives and direct observation of the ecosystem.

The collected footage and sounds were transformed into two collaborative audiovisual installations. One of them was interactive and used a MIDI controlled wheel that allowed visitors to navigate through the video timeline, moving across different visual and spatial perspectives of the moor. The project brought scientific knowledge, artistic experimentation and public participation into the same process, using audiovisual tools to explore relationships and scales that are usually difficult to perceive.

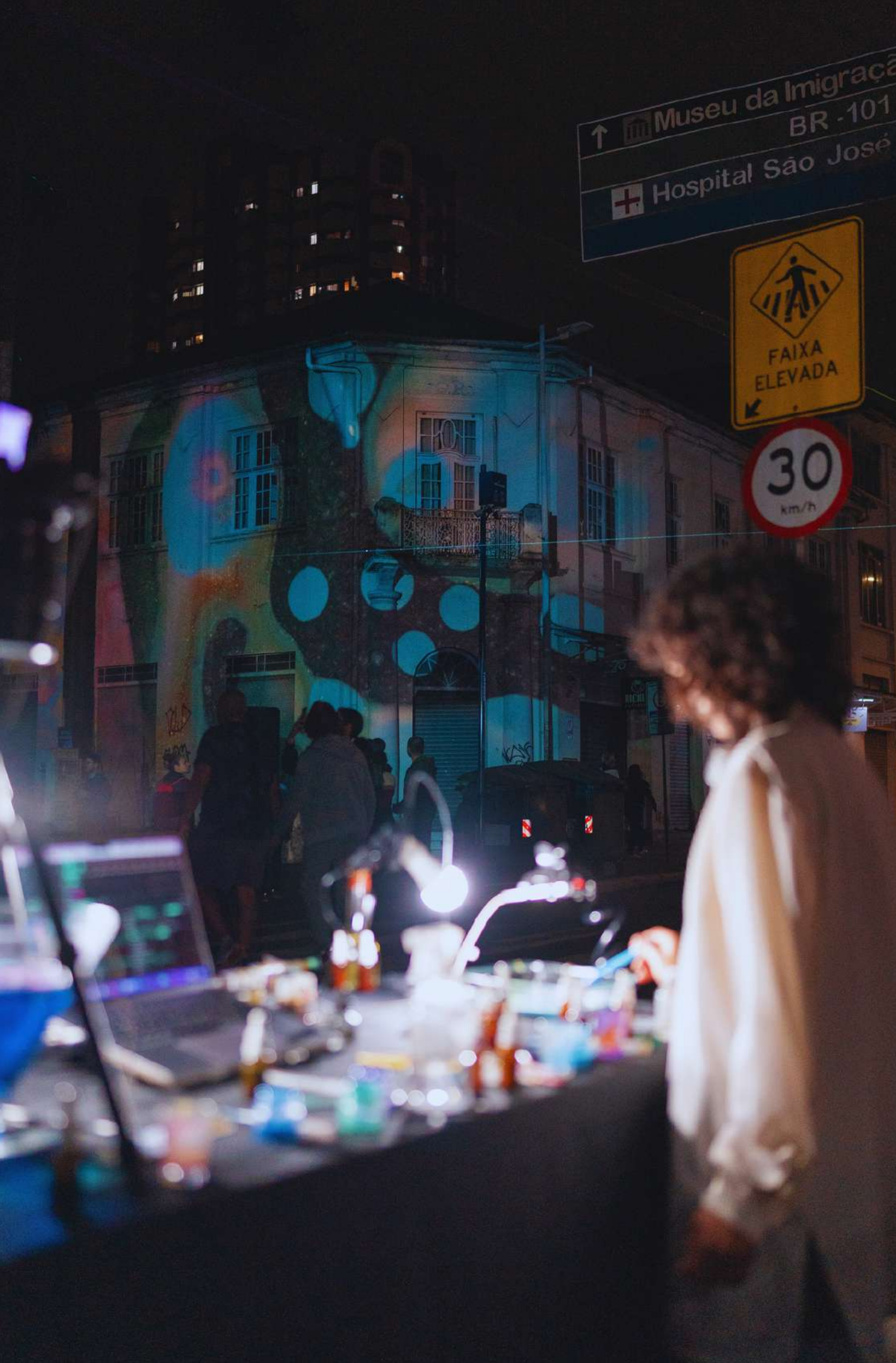

Detail of touch audio-reactive sensor.

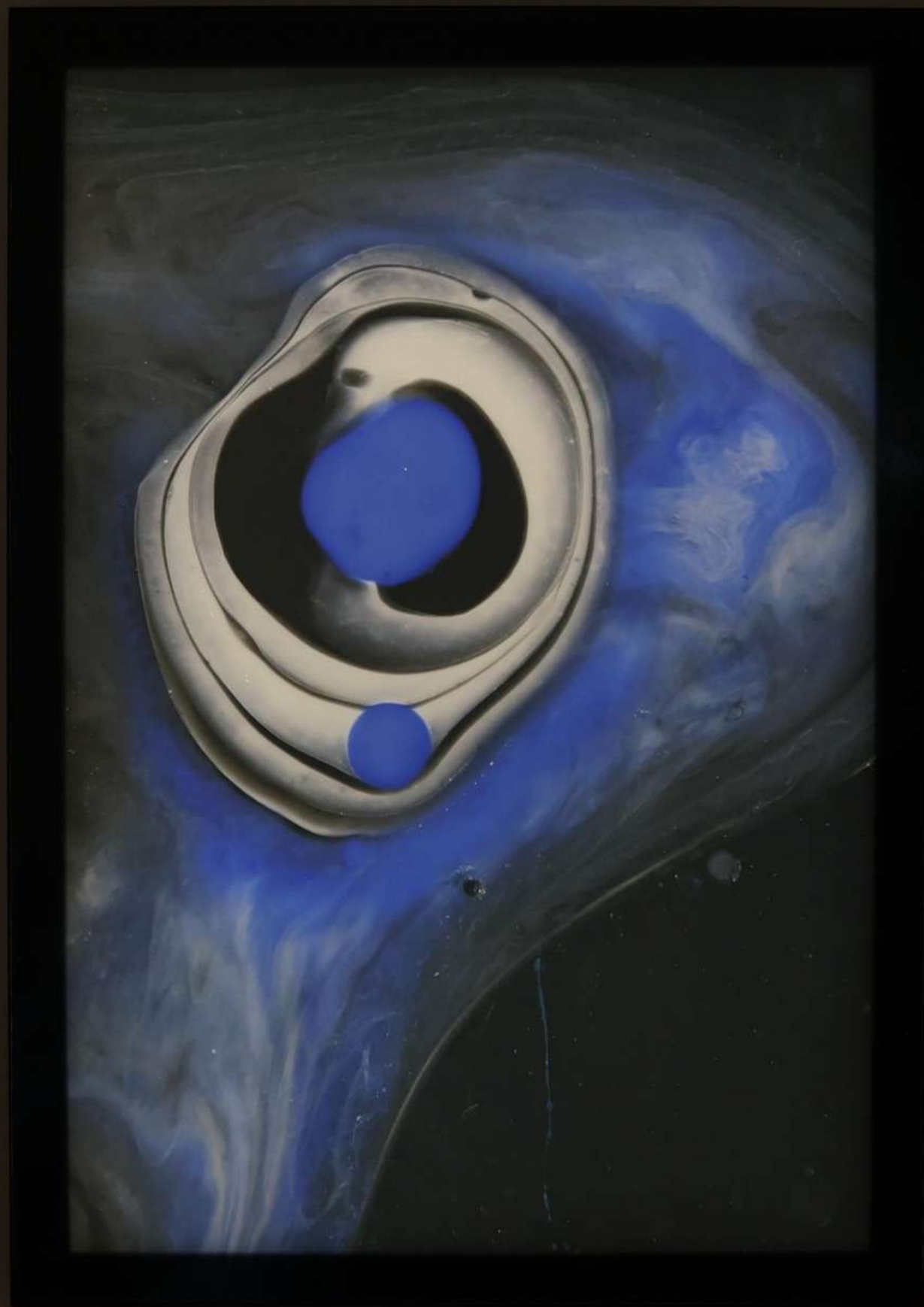

Developed during The Palace Art Residency, The Diverse Sexuality of Flowers explores botanical sexuality and reproductive diversity as a way of reimagining human understandings of sex, gender and identity. Rock the Mountain is a large scale music and arts festival with an audience of over one hundred thousand people. Via presented live visuals in the Chill Out Dome, an immersive stage that merges DJ sets and VJ performances into a continuous audiovisual experience. Curated by MOV Festival.



SSA Mapping 2023 took place at the Church of Nosso Senhor do Bonfim, a major cultural and religious landmark in Salvador, Bahia.

The festival brings together international artists working with projection mapping and immersive audiovisual installations.

This collective video mapping work was created by Via, Kaue Lima and VJ Não Consta, and curated by VJ Spetto as part of the main program.

The piece was structured in three acts, each developed by a different artist.

Act I, created by Via, explores the evolution of life on Earth, interweaving Yoruba cosmology with scientific narratives. From cosmic origins to the emergence of life in the ocean, the work expands into ecosystems and ancestral cultural legacies.

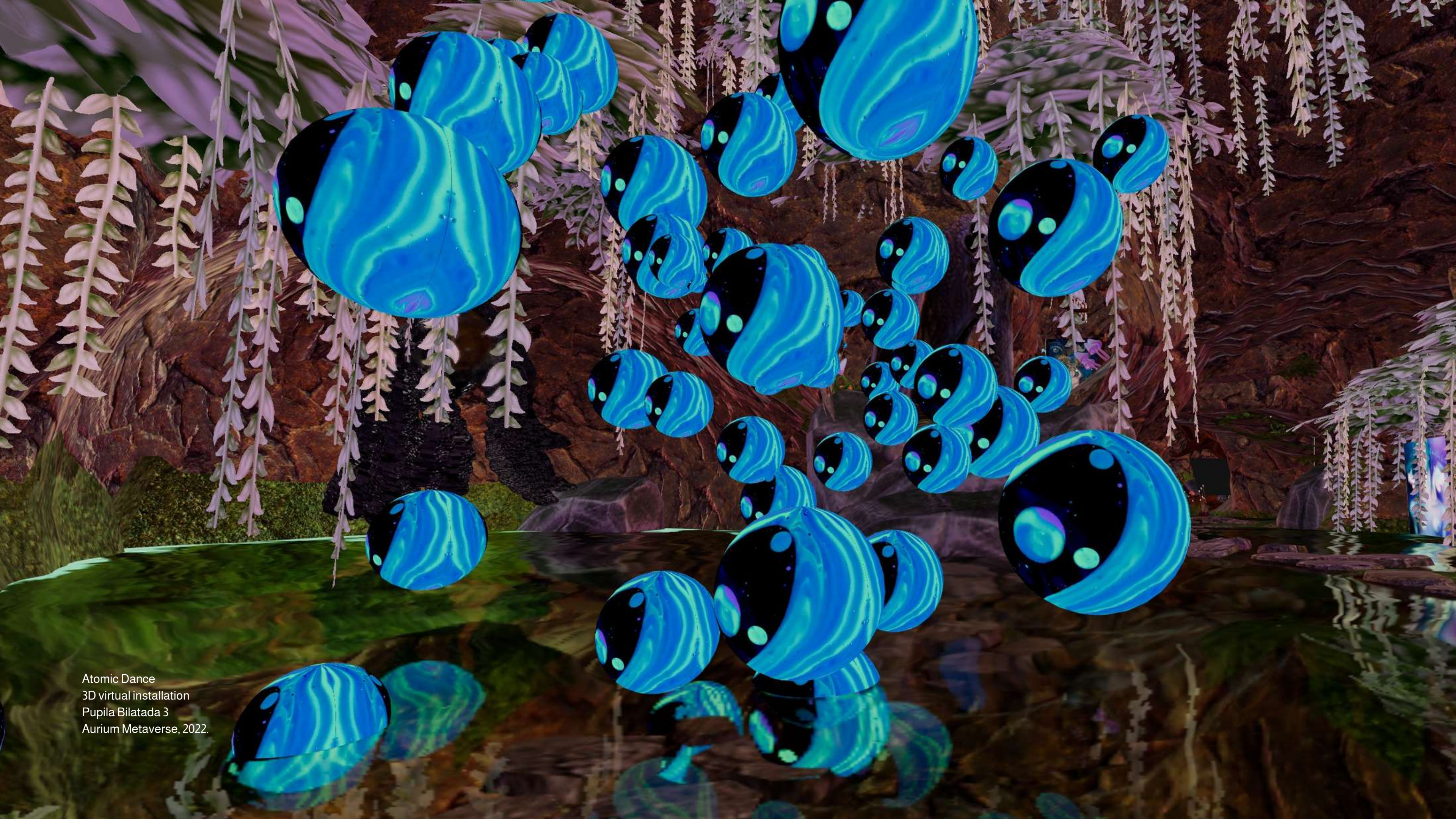

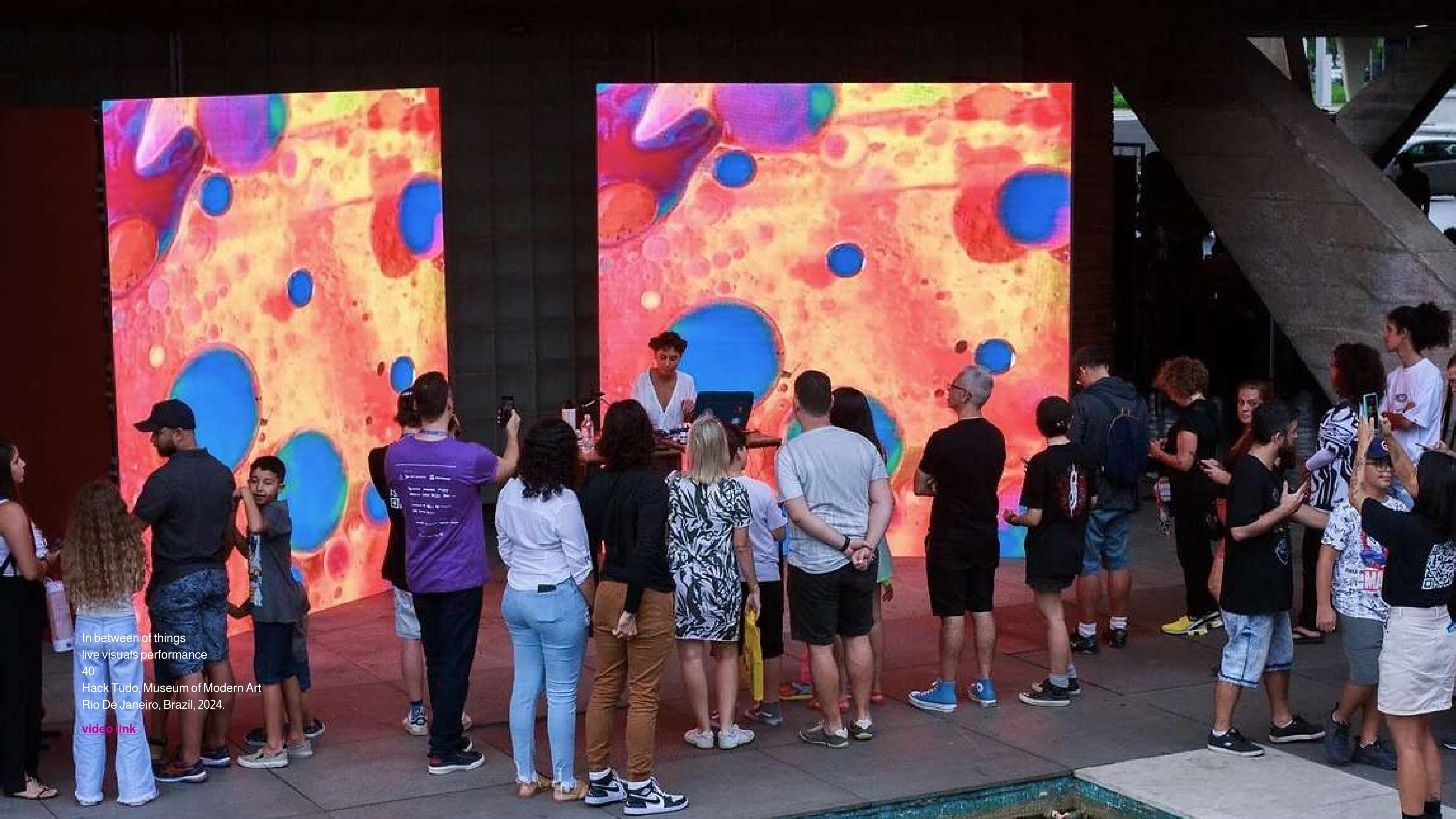
